



Nickname: Stephen of Blois



Top Fact: Invaded and conquered Wales and built an 'iron ring' of castles to maintain power, including Conwy, Harlech, Caernarfon and Beaumaris castles.

Nickname: Edward of Caernarvon

House: The Plantagenets

Ruled: 1307-1327 (20 years)

Age at Start of Rule: 23

Number of Children: 4

Top Fact: His queen, Isabella, invaded England and deposed Edward in favour of their teenage son.

Nickname: Edward of Windsor



Ruled: 1327-1377 (50 years)

Number of Children: 12, 13 or 14

Top Fact: It is thought that almost everyone with mainly British ancestry is probably descended from Edward III.



Name: Richard II

Ruled: 1377-1399 (22 years)

Age at Start of Rule: 10

Number of Children: 0

Top Fact: Grandson of Edward III. Forced to abdicate by his cousin, Henry Bolingbroke, who then became King Henry IV.

Nickname: Henry Bolingbroke

House: Lancaster

Ruled: 1399-1413 (14 years)

Age at Start of Rule: 33

Number of Children: 6

Top Fact:

Had to contend with many rebellions, especially Welsh rebellions led by Owain Glyndwr. Was ill for much of his reign.

Nickname: Henry of Monmouth

House: Lancaster

Ruled: 1413-1422 (9 years)

Age at Start of Rule: 26

Number of Children: 1

Top Fact: The first English king to read and write fluently in English (rather than French).



Name: Henry VI

Nickname: none

House: Lancaster

Ruled: 1422-1461 (22 years) 1470-1471

Age at Start of Rule: 9 months

Number of Children: 1

Top Fact: As Henry was only a baby when he became king, a special council ran the country for him until he was 16.



Name: Edward IV

Nickname: none

House: York

Ruled: 1461-1483 (22 years) briefly deposed 1470-1471

Age at Start of Rule: 19

Number of Children: 7

Top Fact: Deposed Henry VI in 1461 then eventually had him murdered after Henry reclaimed the crown in 1470-71.

Name: Edward V

Nickname: one of the 'Princes in the Tower'

House: York

Ruled: 1483 (2 months)

Age at Start of Rule: 12

Number of Children: 0

Top Fact: Held captive with his brother in the Tower of London by their uncle, Richard III. The boys soon disappeared, supposedly murdered.

Number of Children: 1

Top Fact: Killed at the Battle of Bosworth Field, ending the Wars of the Roses. His remains were discovered under a car park in Leicester in 2012 and reburied in Leicester Cathedral in 2015.

Nickname: Henry Tudor

House: The Tudors

Ruled: 1485-1509 (24 years)

Age at Start of Rule: 28

Number of Children: 8

Top Fact: Henry married Elizabeth of York, the older sister of the Princes in the Tower. The Tudor rose is a mixture of the white rose of York and the red rose of Lancaster, symbolising their unity.

Ruled: 1509-1547 (38 years)

Age at Start of Rule: 18

Number of Children: 3

Top Fact: Henry had six wives. The first, Catherine of Aragon, was his brother Arthur's widow. By divorcing her, he became head of a newly independent, Protestant Church of England.

Top Fact: Edward was determined not to let his half-sisters Mary and Elizabeth succeed him and nominated Lady Jane Grey and her heirs instead. However, he was ultimately unsuccessful.

Top Fact: Jane was proclaimed queen after Edward VI died, but his sister Mary had much more support and overturned Jane's succession after 9 days. Jane was executed for high treason.



Top Fact:

Top Fact: James was already King of Scotland when he became King of England too. He survived the Gunpowder Plot designed to blow him up at the opening of Parliament in 1605.

Top Fact: Charles insisted that God intended kings to be fully in charge and argued with his government. By 1642, this had degenerated into a civil war. Charles was defeated and executed.

Number of Children:

Top Fact: Until 1653, Oliver Cromwell was just the chairman of a council that ran the country. However, the army distrusted them so Oliver eventually had to rule as Lord Protector.

Top Fact:

An army council who disagreed with Parliament forced Richard to step down. They made it possible for Charles II to be restored as king a year later.

George suffered from intermittent periods of insanity. These became worse towards the end of his life and his son was appointed regent to officially rule on his behalf until he died.


Ruled: 1952 - 2022 (70 years and 214 days)
