A reflection of Sunday's Gospel:

In this passage, Jesus takes Peter, James, and John up a mountain where He is transfigured before them. The disciples are filled with awe and wonder at this incredible sight. This event reminds us of the power and glory of Jesus, and how He is truly the Son of God. During this Lenten season, we are called to draw closer to Jesus and reflect on His divinity and love for us. Like the disciples, we should be filled with awe and wonder at the majesty of Christ and His sacrifice for us.
