- Engage in dialogue and communication respectfully with members of school staff.

- Inform the class teacher of any concerns or difficulties that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Ensure that my child attends school regularly, on time and suitably equipped.
- Ensure that my child wears the correct uniform and conventional hairstyle, as per the school policy.
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about my child's progress.
- Seek to participate in the events and activities of the school community.
- Ensure that my child is brought to school on time and that we don't take holidays in term time.
